- cultural events in the first half of the 19th century (opening of the first printing shops, first coffee houses which became social hubs for local intellectuals, first theatres etc.)

- Students will write a seminar paper related to the topics discussed in class

Day 3

- Introducing the students to the authors who wrote in Italian in the first half of the 19th century. (2h)
- Individual work/exercise. (2h)

Day 4

- Analysis of selected texts from the period of Romanticism. (2h)
- Individual work/exercise. (2h)

Day 5

- Multilingualism in Dalmatia. (1h)
- The status of intellectuals in Split. (1h)
- Students' final projects and evaluation of final projects. (2h)
